[Note : Differences from the OULP-C1V1]

- In the process of size-normalized silhouette creation,
 - ✓ Bounding box of each silhouette region becomes more accurate (sub-pixel order)
 - ✓ Size of moving-average filter is changed
- As a result, the number of subjects in each subset and range (start and end frame numbers) of each subject are changed
